STAR25 Parking Plan

Greetings and welcome to STAR25!

This email is sent to all registrants as of 9/16/25.

The host hotel for STAR25 is the Genetti in downtown Williamsport, PA. Being in a downtown location means that parking options are a bit tighter than we have seen at typically more sub-urban facilities. At present, the registration is at 137 people. At this number, we should have plenty of parking spaces available. But if registration surges as the weather-wary decide to attend, things could get to be tight.

YOU WILL BE RECEIVING AN E-MAIL, PLEASE RESPOND TO THAT EMAIL, IF YOU WILL BE BRINGING A TRAILER AND SPECIFY WHETHER YOU WILL NEED A 2-SPACE PULL-THROUGH SPOT OR CAN FIT THE TRAILER IN A SINGLE SPOT. PLEASE ALSO SPECIFY THE DATE AND TIME THAT YOU EXPECT TO ARRIVE.

The hotel has a large lot on the north side of the facility. The entrance is on the left just past the hotel building on Williams St. (one-way heading north). Please see the map, below.

NOTE: Be very careful about on-street parking. All nearby spots are metered and the city is ferocious about ticketing vehicles if the meter is not fed.

<u>For motorcycles, cars, and vehicles with small trailers</u>, please enter at the entrance gate, just past the hotel building. Stop at the toll gate and press the intercom button to identify yourself as being registered at the hotel for STAR. After you have your room key, that can be used to open the gate.

<u>For vehicles with smaller trailers</u>, please enter through the toll gates and proceed to the north end (far end) of the lot, then back the trailer in to the spaces along Hepburn St. See the orange rectangle. This section will be marked off using cones.

<u>For vehicles with larger trailers</u>, please enter at the "bus" gate. One of the coordinators will be there to direct traffic and to direct other vehicles to the toll gates. The first trailers will pull straight in and to the left to fill the pull-through spots in the GREEN section, filling from closest to the hotel to farther away. When that section is filled, the next trailers will fill in the yellow section, again filling from closer to the hotel to farther away. Last, if needed, we will use the blue section.

The hotel expects to be near to capacity for the weekend. They have overflow lots nearby and have arrangements with two commercial parking lots. Also, we are asking the local Harley-Davidson dealer if we can park some trailers at their facility – about 2.5 miles east of the hotel, in Montoursville.
